Fernie Alpine Resort is a ski resort, located on Lizard Range, near the town of Fernie, British Columbia in Canada. The resort has 10 lifts servicing 142 named runs, 5 alpine bowls, and tree skiing with a vertical drop of 3,550 ft. The resort has over 2,500 acres of skiable terrain and receives an average annual snowfall of over 28 ft. On the slopes of the resort, the Fernie Slopeside Lodge is a relaxed ski-in/ski-out hotel with a timber exterior and is a 1-minute walk to the nearest ski lift. Bright rooms with pine furnishings feature Wi-Fi access and flat-screens, as well as microwaves, minifridges and coffeemakers. Amenities include free parking, a convenience store as well as ski storage, a BBQ area and coin-operated laundry facilities.

A 3-minute walk from Banff's restaurants and shops, the Banff Aspen Lodge offers low-key rooms which include Wi-Fi, TVs, minifridges, and tea and coffeemaking equipment. A breakfast buffet is served in a relaxed dining room, and there's an on-site cafe. Other amenities include a courtyard with a hot tub and an outdoor fireplace. There's also a meeting room, and bike and ski gear storage. A short walk to a bus stop provides shuttle access to Norquay, Sunshine and Lake Louise ski resorts. Banff Sunshine ski runs and lifts are accessed via an eight-person high-speed gondola. It moves passengers from the parking lot (or bus terminal) to Goat's Eye mountain in 10 minutes and to the upper Village area in 18 minutes. There are 9 chairlifts and 134 trails within the alpine valley formed by the three mountains (Mount Standish, Lookout Mountain, and Goat's Eye Mountain) that constitute Banff Sunshine. Lake Louise includes over 4,200 skiable acres of world-class terrain speak. The unique layout with beginner, intermediate and expert runs from every chair allows your family or group of varying abilities to ski and share the experience together. The resort offers endless chutes, glades and gullies, gentle slopes, cruising runs, remote bowls and some of the most challenging terrain in the Rockies.
