Mountain: Vertical 5,620 feet, 3,031 acres of terrain. 5 bowls and the longest run of 9.5 miles. 7% beginner, 45% intermediate and 48% advanced.

The hotel features spacious rooms with gas fireplace, 40" flat screen TV, WIFI, The Blarney Stone Irish Tavern, indoor/outdoor pool, outdoor hot tub, exercise room, and ski storage.
