ABILITY LEVEL GUIDELINE

SKI SCHOOL ABILITY LEVEL

- LEVEL 1 _____ Never skied before (magic carpet only)
- LEVEL 2 _____ Slight direction change / can stop in a wedge
- LEVEL 3 _____ Round wedge and rides chair
- LEVEL 4 _____ Round controlled wedge turns and skis green trails
- LEVEL 5 _____ Skies parallel in middle of turn
- LEVEL 6 _____ Match skis parallel most of the time while skiing blues
- LEVEL 7 _____ Wide stance parallel turns using poles on blues
- LEVEL 8 _____ Short systematic parallel turns on more difficult terrain
- LEVEL 9 _____ Short, balanced parallel turns on bumps, powder and ice

SNOWBOARD SCHOOL ABILITY LEVEL

- LEVEL 1 _____ First time (magic carpet only)
- LEVEL 2 _____ Performs falling leaf with confidence
- LEVEL 3 _____ Elementary linked turns on greens
- LEVEL 4 _____ Performs various radius turns on blues
- LEVEL 5 _____ Carved turns, elementary tricks over all of mountain
